## SCHOOL CALENDAR

## FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal statistical year will begin on the first day of July in each year and end June 30th on the following year.

## SCHOOL YEAR

The calendar for the succeeding year will be approved before/at the regular meeting of the Board of Education in February. The length of the school day and the opening and closing of the sessions will be recommended by the Superintendent. In constructing the school calendar, the following principles will govern:

- A. The school year will be 180 days unless granted a waiver by DPI.
- B. Guidelines for constructing the calendar to be delivered in accordance with state statute. When Labor Day falls on September 1st to 4th, school will open the following Tuesday. School will open on the previous Monday when Labor Day falls during the period of September 5th to 7th.
- B. Winter Vacation

When Christmas falls on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, school will close for vacation on the previous Friday. When Christmas falls on Thursday or Friday, school will close on the respective Tuesday or Wednesday. School will reopen the day following the first or second school day of the New Year.

- C. Spring Vacation
  - School will be closed for Good Friday and the Monday following Easter Sunday. School will reopen on the first Tuesday after Easter.
- D. Holidays

The school office will be closed on the following holidays, except as the superintendent may determine such closing contrary to the best interests of the Board:

Labor Day Thanksgiving Day
Christmas Day New Years Day
Good Friday Memorial Day

Independence Day
