SECTION: STUDENT

SCHOOL ADMISSIONS

The District of Colby will screen all students for admissions in accordance with state statutes. The District is not required to admit a student during the term of his/her expulsion from another school district. The District shall not discriminate in admissions to any school, class, program or activity or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. This policy does not, however, prohibit the district from placing a student in a school, class, program or activity based on objective standards of individual performance or need. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
