POLICY#: 453.2 SECTION: STUDENT

IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR SCHOOL ENTRY

- 1. Every early childhood and kindergarten student must show evidence of having had immunizations as required by Wisconsin Statute. These requirements may be waived for an individual student for health reasons (signed by a physician), personal or religious convictions (signed by parent/guardian), with such signature on file with the school.
- 2. All new students admitted to any school in the district shall present written evidence within 30 school days to the school of having had immunizations as required by Wisconsin Statute. A student may be waived from the immunization requirement when the student, if an adult, or the student's parent, guardian or legal custodian submits a written statement objecting to the immunization for reasons of health, religion or personal conviction.
