AGR Performance Objectives and Progress Semester 2 2017-18

Our data is available in our Grade Level Intervention folder in Google Docs. We keep track of: when students enter and exit and what they did during that time. We regroup about every 6 weeks, some leave and some come in each time and the skills taught are (usually) different. Our Objectives are based on our local curriculum standards for ELA and Math.

We use DRA, CBMs, AIMs Web, PALS, sight words, and Every Day Math assessments to determine interventions. Both Mrs Peterson and Mrs McConnell pull small groups and go into the 2nd and 3rd grade rooms to team teach.

Math K-3

Our students in grades K-3 are served in math by Mrs. McConnell. She uses a program called Math Addvantage to pretest students identified on the Needs Assessment. Mrs. McConnell pulls out small groups to work on foundational skills while the rest of the class works on things that are not as foundational. When they return to class the teacher works on the core math lesson with all students. Mrs. McConnell shares strategies with teachers that will help all students perform better in math. She uses the CCSS to help teachers focus on what is "have to know" in EveryDay Math and what is "nice to know". She tests students (progress monitors) at the end of each trimester as well. This data is also used for our end of year needs assessment.

3rd grade-13 students were in Mrs. McConnell's program second semester. Her groups have worked on: add /subtract, multiplication story problems, and place value. She does one on one tutoring with one student. Mrs Medenwaldt had one student one on one the second semester. 2nd grade- 21 students were in Mrs McConnells group second semester. Those groups have worked on: counting forward and backward within 120 and basic fact strategies word problems.

1st grade- The second semester every first grader was in an intervention group with one of the TEAM teachers. They have worked on: counting to 120, before and after, and CGI (Cognitively Guided Instruction) story problems. Mrs. McConnell's groups worked on place value, add and subtracting 10, and counting.

Kindergarten- 15 students were in Mrs. McConnell's math pull out for Rote counting/writing and number ID to 25. All Kindergarten students had math intervention with one of the TEAM teachers. They worked on counting, skip counting, adding and subtracting 1, reading/writing #s, and #ID.

Reading K-1

Our students in K-1 are served in ELA by Mrs. Woik/Mrs. Dix. She uses a few different programs one of which is Wonder Works; that is part of our Reading Wonders series to supplement what they are learning in ELA. She generally does small group pull out, but has also done one on one tutoring as well. She also shares strategies with teachers that will help all students perform better in reading.

We use PALS and DRA testing to determine needs in K and 1. Kindergarten small groups worked on Letter ID and sounds (14), Word Families (5), and Retelling (12). 1st Grade small groups worked on Letter sounds (7) and WonderWorks (5).

Reading 2-3

Our students in grades 2-3 are served in ELA by Mrs. Peterson . She uses a few different programs: Wonder Works, the Sonday System, handwriting, and helps with modified spelling and sight words. She also does push in/team teaching in both 2nd and 3rd grade, and shares strategies with teachers. 14 second grade students are in either sight words, Guided Reading, Sonday, Wonder Works, and/or phonics instruction second semester, and 9 Third grade students were in her pullout groups second semester. One student was Teir 3 intervention.

POLICY#: 470

SECTION: INSTRUCTION

STUDENT FEES POLICY

The School District of Colby supports the need to provide a free public education to all children enrolled. The District may charge student fees for certain activities, courses and services which may require additional funding and may assess charges when school property is damaged or lost. No district wide student enrollment fees will be assessed.

Student fees will be reviewed by the Board Superintendent annually. Any new or increased student fees will be Board approved. Fee schedules shall be consistent with state and federal laws and regulations. Receipts for all student fees shall be completed.

Collection of Fees and Charges

The District Administrator or designee shall be expected to protect the taxpayers of the District by making every effort to collect all fees and charges due the District. The District may use small claims court or collection agencies/services to collect student's debts, fees and charges due to the district prior to issuance of the diplomas participation in Commencement.

General policy

The Board of Education shall furnish such textbooks, supplies, supplementary texts, and instructional materials as are necessary to the best implementation of the curriculum in all grades.

Exceptions (Any exception must be authorized by the principal.)

Expendable materials in the nature of laboratory manuals, bookkeeping workbooks, agriculture workbooks, and other aids that become the personal property of the student shall be purchased by the school and sold to the student at cost.

Any student who, through the course of instruction, produces any article for his their personal use or ownership, will pay the cost of the material used in the construction of each article.

The Board may also charge for instruction, instruments, or specialized equipment/apparatus necessary for study or extra-curricular involvements.

Part II SECTION 8. POST-EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS

8.01 Voluntary Early Retirement Benefit Program

A. Eligibility

Teachers will be eligible for the early retirement benefit provided for in this Article if a) they declare, in writing, to the Board of Education, their retirement intentions prior to February 1 of the calendar year in which they intend to retire from an employer contributing to the Wisconsin Retirement System, b) are WRS eligible for retirement and c) were hired prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

B. Application and Limitation

Application for participation in the early retirement benefit provided for in this Article must be made by the teacher in writing and submitted to the School Board on or before February 1st of the last school year prior to retirement from an employer contributing to the Wisconsin Retirement System. No more than three (3) teachers shall be eligible to begin participation in the early retirement benefits provided for in this Article in the same year unless the School Board, at its sole discretion, approves a higher number. In the event there are more applicants than are eligible to participate, the most senior applicants, based on Colby School District experience, will be selected. If seniority is equal, the selection will be based on the order of receipt of the application.

C. Early Retirement Benefit Health Insurance

For Staff hired prior to July 1, 1986

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

- 1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for insurance premiums upon retirement.
- 2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.
- 3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 1986, yet prior to July 1, 1992

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$100,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

- 1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.
- 2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.
- 3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 1992, yet prior to July 1, 2004.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$75,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

- 1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.
- 2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.
- 3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2004, yet prior to July 1, 2009.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$50,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

- 1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.
- 2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.
- 3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2009, yet prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$25,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

- 1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.
- 2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.
- 3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon employment, for an eligible teacher, the District will contribute \$500 annually (each year of service) to a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) for utilization upon retirement from the Colby School District.

D. Payment of Benefit

1a) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 1986

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, a monthly benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by the number of months until the employee becomes entitled to Medicare eligibility.

1b) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, an annual benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by 5.

- 2) Retired employees may use the HRA credit for premium only health reimbursement account from a third party vendor selected by the district.
- 3) Retired employees who return to work in any position which offers health insurance shall have their benefit suspended until they no longer work in a position that is eligible for health insurance, subject to the terms for participation eligibility. Upon termination of any health insurance qualifying post retirement employment, monthly benefits with the Colby School District will be recalculated as described in Part II, Section 8, D(1a) and D(1b).
- 4) Decisions made by the District in the interpretation and operation of this benefit offering shall be in its sole discretion and are final and binding. In the event of any review of a decision by a court of law, the reviewing tribunal shall give deference to the District's decision, confirming such decision, unless it is shown that the District acted in an arbitrary and capricious manner. The decision of the District on all issues under this offering shall be final.

66.03.01 Agreement – Students Open to Achieving Reality (SOAR) 18-21 year old program in the Medford Area Public School District

2018-19 School Year

Pursuant to Wisconsin Statutes 66.03.01, 120.25, and Department of Public Instruction Chapter PI-14.02, the school districts of Medford and Colby have agreed to form a consortium for the purpose of providing services to students with an IEP who are between the ages 18-21 years of old and their class has graduated from high school.

Description of the Program (PI-14.02 (b)):

- SOAR program is an opportunity for 18-21 year old students with disabilities who have an IEP
 that need additional time to work on IEP goals/objectives in the areas of independent/daily living,
 work/vocational skills, and/or preparatory college skills.
- The Medford Area Public School District personnel will provide assessment, placement, programming, and instruction.
- Resident school districts will remain responsible for the writing and development of their student's Individualized Education Plan with information provided by Medford Area Public School District
- Medford Area Public School District will provide the room space located within the Taylor County Education Center building
- 18-21 year old students will attend school Mondays through Thursdays from approximately 8:30 am to 12:30 pm in the Taylor County Education Center.
- 18-21 year old students will attend work or volunteer sites in the afternoons in their local resident school district community.
- Students will need to complete an application packet and be accepted into the program by the SOAR Advisory Council.
- Resident school district will maintain copies of student's high school diploma until completion of the SOAR program.

Fiscal Agent

- The Medford Area Public School District is the "employer" for purposes of compliance with State Statute 111.70 (teacher's retirement, worker's compensation, and unemployment insurance) for the primary instructor and classroom assistant(s).
- The resident school district will be the "employer" for purposes of compliances with State Statute 111.70 for any job coaches.
- The Medford Area Public School District is the fiscal agent and will establish and maintain
 records in accordance with the uniform financial accounting system prescribed by the department
 under s. 115.28 (13); file all required financial reports with the Department of Public Instruction;
 Upon request of the department, file a copy of the contract and the plan of operation with the
 department.

 For purposes of transit of aid, in accordance of State Statute 121.76, the Colby and Rib Lake School Districts shall receive a proportional share of state or federal aid for pupils for whom Medford School District received tuition.

Transportation (PI-14.02 (g))

• Each home district is responsible for determining policy and protocol for transportation of students to and from SOAR classroom and work sites

Pupil Membership (PI-14.02 (f))

- The Medford, Colby and Rib Lake School Districts will claim respective attending students as
 residents and receive the equalization aid for them, subject to the annual reconciliation described
 in the following section.
- For the purpose of DPI Pupil Count reporting (PI 1563), each district will count their attendees of SOAR as residents in the initial starting Head Count.

Budget Reconciliation (PI-14.02 (f)(h)):

- The Medford Area Public School District will prepare a preliminary budget for SOAR. The
 participation fee will be invoiced in January 2019, with actual and final reconciliation prior to
 June 30, 2019.
- A \$7,500 participation fee will be charged to each school in the consortium.
- Costing will be based on a percentage of overall program costs divided by total number of students (after subtraction of participation fees).
