RELATIONS WITH OTHER SCHOOLS AND AGENCIES

The Board of Education of the School District of Colby appreciates the fact that there are other agencies in the district, or area, which are dedicated to education. It believes that much may be gained through cooperative endeavors with these agencies.

In order to make a maximum contribution to education, within the school district and to other education agencies, the Board establishes these broad guideline:

- 1. Efforts will be made to establish mutually beneficial cooperative programs with neighboring schools and other schools in CESA #10. This also includes the purchase of special services and equipment not economically available to the local district due to budget or personnel restraints.
- 2. The school administration is encouraged to establish liaison with other educational and noneducational agencies and to explore shared services, programs, and personnel as a means to enhancing district services and mitigating costs.
- 3. The school administration is encouraged to supply educational services to and/or share with, other educational and non-educational agencies.
- 4. Non-district residents may be charged higher fees for obtaining district services than fees offered to residents of the School District of Colby.
