Elementary Doors

Drop off zone

Drivers must enter for the east side of Dolf Street. Stay on the right hand side of the driveway. Pull up close to the curb so that your students enter the sidewalk from the passenger side of the vehicle closest to the building. Staff members monitor the drop off area and assist if needed. Drivers stay in their vehicles in order to keep the flow of traffic moving. When your child is safely out of the vehicle, exit the west end of the driveway onto Dolf Street. Safety is our focus. Alway watch for student that might be crossing the driveways, either walking or riding bike. We ask that you be considerate of one another by holding up traffic. If you plan to exit your vehicle, please full into a parking spot. At no time should an unaccompanied vehicle be left in the driveway.
