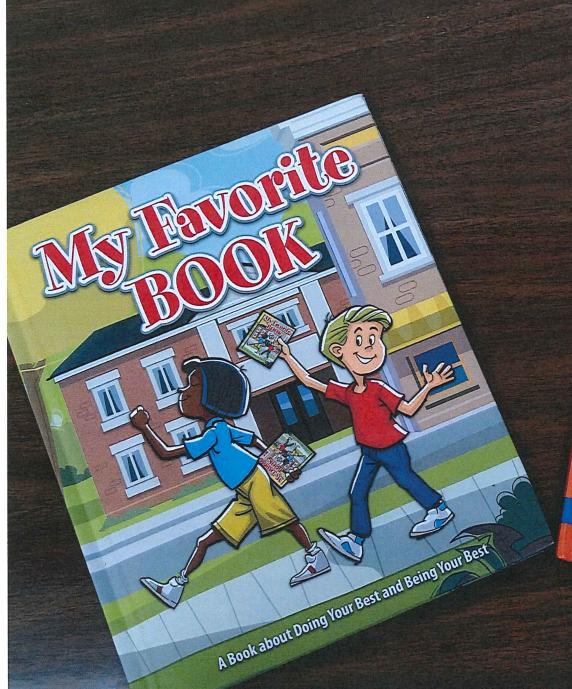

### INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT'S REPORT ON APPLYING AGREED-UPON PROCEDURES

To the Board of Education School District of Colby 705 N. 2nd Street P.O. Box 139 Colby, WI 54421-0139

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the School District of Colby (the specified party), on the analysis of the credit card charges of the School District of Colby for the period April 18, 2016 through January 21, 2019. The School District of Colby's management is responsible for the credit card charges. The sufficiency of these procedures is solely the responsibility of the School District of Colby. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures described below, either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose.

The procedures and associated findings are as follows:

- 1. Obtain the monthly statements for the Royal Credit Union, Walmart and County Market credit cards used during the period of April 18, 2016 through January 21, 2019 and perform a detailed review as follow:
  - A. Obtain the District's supporting documentation for the purchases/charges shown on the monthly statements:
    - 1. Determine if each purchase is supported by:
      - a. An original itemized receipt (i.e., identifies precisely what was purchased)
      - b. Documentation of the business/public purpose (Note: For meal charges, there should also be documentation of the individuals participating)
      - c. Other documentation as may be required by policy (e.g., purchase order, authorization, etc.)
    - 2. Determine if each purchase is:
      - a. In accordance with thresholds or guidelines established in the policies and procedures.
      - b. For an appropriate and necessary business purpose relative to the entity.

*Finding*: We noted 35 credit card charges totaling \$7,020.03 which were not supported by an itemized receipt, were not in accordance with District purchasing policies and were not for District purposes.

2. Determine if any purchases were made for personal purposes. If there are purchases made for personal purposes, determine the date(s) of reimbursement.

*Finding:* We noted 35 credit card charges totaling \$7,020.03 which were made for personal purposes and were not subsequently reimbursed to the District.



3. Determine if any purchases effectively circumvented the District's normal procurement/purchasing process.

*Finding:* We noted 35 credit card charges totaling \$7,020.03 which effectively circumvented the District's normal purchasing process.

This agreed-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. We were not engaged to and did not conduct an examination or review, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion or conclusion, respectively, on the analysis of credit card charges. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion or conclusion. Had we performed additional procedures, other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.

### **PURCHASING AUTHORITY**

The purchasing, receiving, storing and distribution of necessary supplies, equipment and services for use in the educational program and for the various auxiliary services represent a significant expenditure in the school budget. These items must be procured efficiently and economically. The measure of efficient, economical purchasing is the degree to which the right items are provided in the right quantity to the right place at the right time.

The function of the purchasing office is to serve the educational program by providing the necessary supplies, equipment and services. The Board of Education declares its intention to purchase competitively without prejudice and to seek maximum educational value for every dollar expended. The acquisition of services, equipment and supplies is centralized in the purchasing department which functions under the supervision of a person designated by the Board as purchasing agent and through whose office all purchasing transactions are conducted.

#### SPECIFIC CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. The superintendent is appointed by the Board to serve as purchasing agent. He/she shall be responsible for developing and administering the purchasing program of the school district.
- 2. The Board of Education authorizes the superintendent to approve non-capital expenditures in the amount of \$5,000 or less to cover any single purchase from the general operating budget which may be required to conduct efficient operations within the school district. Purchases over this amount shall be by Board authorization.
- 3. All contracts for and purchases of supplies, materials, equipment and contractual services in the amount of \$2,500 or more shall be based, when possible, on at least two competitive bids.
- 4. Bids are not required for:
  - a. Educational items such as textbooks, books, media, workbooks, kits, periodicals.
  - b. Replacement parts for existing equipment where the value of the replacement parts are estimated to be less than 50% of the total value of the existing contracts.
  - c. CESA contracts
  - d. Maintenance contracts of at least one year's duration where the maintenance is to, be performed on routine or as needed basis on specified equipment and shall include the additional cost of all repair or replacement parts.
- 5. All contracts which require public advertising and competitive bidding shall be awarded by Board action. Recommendations for the award of all such contracts shall be submitted to the Board by the chief school officer.
- 6. The District may seek to pre-qualify vendors for ongoing project work.

#### LOCAL PURCHASING

It shall be the policy of this school district to purchase locally, provided goods of equal quality and at competitive prices are available from local suppliers.

The district purchasing agent should not feel bound to purchase any item locally that can be secured at a saving to this school district from outside sources, nor shall he/she feel bound to purchase locally unless adequate service and delivery can be given by the local supplier.

### PURCHASE ORDER PROCEDURES

Orders paid for with district funds on a purchase order must be approved by the immediate supervisor and school district administrator in advance of the purchase.

### PURCHASING OF SUPPLIES, MATERIALS, AND EQUIPMENT

This includes any outlay of expenditures, that is, any money spent by the district must be on a local purchase order or Board of Education purchase order.

- a. All items purchased must be approved.
- b. Supplies, materials and equipment shall not be purchased without proper authorization and items will not be accepted upon delivery unless accompanied by a district purchase order. All orders must be billed or invoiced to the Board of Education, School District of Colby.
- c. The school address shall not be used for personal mail, orders, etc. Employees of the School District of Colby who wish to order supplies, materials, or equipment for their personal use must use their home address for ordering and billing purposes. Personal items billed to the school shall become the property of the district and be returned to the vendor for reimbursement.
- d. In emergency situations, it may be necessary to request checks for entry fees, registrations, etc. from the bookkeeper with the superintendent's approval.

### AGR Performance Objectives and Progress

### Semester 1 2018-19

Our data is available in our Grade Level Intervention folder in Google Docs. We keep track of: when students enter and exit and what they did during that time. We regroup about every 6 weeks, some leave and some come in each time and the skills taught are (usually) different. In addition to these groups there are also one on one pull outs as time allows. Interventionists come into the classrooms and team teach as well. All of this is documented in the Google Doc.

Our Objectives are based on our local curriculum standards for ELA and Math.

Our students in grades K-3 are serviced in math by Mrs. McConnell. She uses a program called Math Addvantage to pre test students who were identified on the Title 1 Needs Assessment. Mrs. McConnell pulls out small groups to work on foundational skills while the rest of the class works on things that are not as foundational. She shares strategies with teachers that will help all students perform better in math. She uses the CCSS to help teachers focus on what is "have to know" in EveryDay Math and what is "nice to know". She uses counting as a screener for intervention. We use AIMS Web and chapter tests for measuring growth along with counting.

3rd grade- So far 11 different students have been in Mrs. McConnell's program at one time or another. Her groups have worked on: counting forward and backward within 1000, and addition /subtraction strategies. She does one on one tutoring with some students. Mrs Wilcox also had one student one on one the second 6 weeks for Tier 3 intervention. On the AIMS web 62/65 made gains 3/65 had the same score. The average 3rd grader went up 17 points on the AIMS web.

2nd grade- This semester, 6 students have been in Mrs McConnells pull out groups. Those groups have worked on: counting forward and backward within 120 and basic fact strategies word problems. Mrs Medenwaldt also had one student one on one the second 6 weeks for Tier 3 intervention.

1st grade- The first 6 weeks every first grader was in an intervention group with one of the TEAM teachers. They have worked on: counting to 120, before and after. The second 6 weeks only 18 students were in intervention counting to 120 or story problems. Then the last 6 weeks only 2 groups of 6 were in an intervention group.

Kindergarten- All kindergarten students have been in math intervention for Rote counting/writing and number ID to 25. Kindergarten waits a bit longer to start pull out to allow students to have core before going straight to intervention. So for the first semester they use the interventionists to "push in" to the classrooms. This allows them to flex the classes by abilities and not have to "pull out". For example in Sept. 35/53 did not meet the expectation to count to 20, but by Jan only 5/52 did not meet the expectation. Also, in Sept. only 2 could count to 100 and by Jan 11 could.

Our students in K-1 are serviced in ELA by Mrs. Woik. She uses a few different programs one of which is Wonder Works; that is part of our Reading Wonders series to supplement what they are learning in ELA.

She generally does small group pull out, but has also done one on one tutoring as well. She also shares strategies with teachers that will help all students perform better in reading.

We use PALS and DRA testing to determine needs in K and 1.

Kindergarten was again a "push in" model. The ability leveled groups worked on Letter ID, sounds, and Sight Words. Data was gathered by PALS testing and DRA testing. From the Fall PALS testing to the Mid Year PALS testing every single student's summed score in those areas went up. In the Fall 7 knew all the letters and sounds and by Mid year 19 knew all the letters and sounds.

1st Grade small groups worked on WonderWorks, Jolly Phonics, sight words, oral reading, and spelling using PALS resources.. In the fall 10 students were below level on the DRA and by Mid Year 9 of them made progress one stayed at the same level. Six still didn't meet expectations, and 3 do meet expectations. PALS summed scores went up an average of 15 points from Fall to Mid Year. only 3 students were ID'd on PALS as needing more support than usual.

Our students in grades 2-3 are serviced in ELA by Mrs. Peterson . She uses a few different programs one of which is the Sonday system, she also helps with modified spelling and sight words. She generally does small group pull out, but has also done push in/team teaching in both 2nd and 3rd grade. She shares strategies with teachers that will help all students perform better in reading.

2nd- This semester, 22 students are in some pull out for either sight words, spelling, Sonday System, and/or phonics instruction.

3rd- This semester, 10 students have been in her pullout groups. Those groups are working on the Sonday System, spelling, and phonics. Mrs. Peterson also had one student for Tier 3 intervention.

We use DRA, CBMs, AIMs Web, PALS, sight words, counting, and Every Day Math assessments to determine interventions. Mrs. Woik, Mrs Peterson, and Mrs McConnell pull small groups for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd grade and go into the kindergarten, 1st, 2nd and 3rd grade rooms to team teach. They do one on one tutoring and assessments.
