

## **PROFESSIONAL STAFF QUALIFICATIONS**

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to employ on the instructional staff only those persons who hold at least a Bachelor's Degree with an academic major in the appropriate subject field and an acceptable state teacher's certificate. Persons appointed to the administrative and supervisory staff shall hold at least a Master's Degree with majors in the appropriate fields.

### **CERTIFICATION**

1. All instructional personnel shall have teaching certificates, duly recorded with the Superintendent of Schools, that legally qualify them for the work to which they are assigned.
2. All instructional personnel employed are expected to keep informed of essential instructional improvements through professional study, group discussions, school visitations, and travel.
