SECTION: PERSONNEL

PROFESSIONAL STAFF QUALIFICATIONS

OUALIFICATIONS

It shall be the policy of the Board of Education to employ on the instructional staff only those persons who hold at least a Bachelor's Degree with an academic major in the appropriate subject field and an acceptable state teacher's certificate. Persons appointed to the administrative and supervisory staff shall hold at least a Master's Degree with majors in the appropriate fields.

CERTIFICATION

- 1. All instructional personnel shall have teaching certificates, duly recorded with the Superintendent of Schools, that legally qualify them for the work to which they are assigned.
- 2. All instructional personnel employed are expected to keep informed of essential instructional improvements through professional study, group discussions, school visitations, and travel.
