Buyer's signed acceptance of a proposal or submission of a signed purchase order for any products or services of Complete Control shall be deemed acceptance of these standard terms and conditions in their entirety and without alteration or supplementation. - 1. Proposal and Prices. Complete Control's proposal(s) for any identified temperature control materials or software and any related and incidental installation or maintenance services ("Products") are firm for the period, and expire on the date, set forth in the proposal. All typographical or clerical errors are subject to correction. The prices quoted are net F.O.B. from Complete Control's headquarters, Port Edwards, Wisconsin. Invoices are due upon receipt by Buyer.
