

NOTICE FOR MILK BIDS

The Board of Education of the School District of Colby will accept bids for delivery of half-pints of Grade A milk in paper cartons for the _____ school year.

1. Prices should be quoted on half-pints of homogenized Grade A whole milk, Grade A 2% milk, lowfat Grade A chocolate milk and Grade A skim milk. The district uses approximately 21,000 half-pints of whole milk, 36,700 half-pints of 2% milk, 182,000 half-pints of chocolate 1% milk and 11,000 half-pints of skim milk during the school year. Also, please include a quote for 4-5# cottage cheese, 4-5# sour cream, and four one-gallon jugs of 2% milk.
2. The successful bidder is to furnish any needed refrigeration for milk in the three elementary school buildings. Please state type of coolers that will be furnished.
3. Bids will be accepted until 12:00 PM, _____. Bids may be delivered in person or mailed to Superintendent, School District of Colby, PO Box 110, 705 N. Second Street, Colby, WI 54421. The envelope must be clearly marked "Milk Bid".
4. The bidder has a right to make proposals other than those above if he feels it is in the best interest of the district.
5. The Board of Education reserves the right to accept or reject any and/or all bids.
