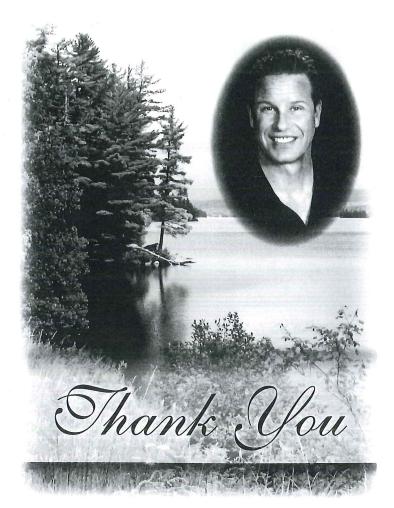

New Laws Modify Requirements for Publishing Legal Notices

Two new laws took effect April 18, 2018, regarding the publication of legal notices in newspapers. 2017 Wisconsin Act 282 modifies the qualifications for newspapers that receive payment for such publication. 2017 Wisconsin Act 353 provides an alternate publication option for Class 2 and Class 3 legal notices.

OVERVIEW OF PUBLICATION AND POSTING OF LEGAL NOTICES

Wis. Stat. Ch. 985 provides requirements for school districts publishing or posting legal notices. A school board can, but does not have to, designate a qualified newspaper which is published or having general circulation in the school district as the official newspaper of the district. If the school board designates a qualified newspaper as the official newspaper of the district, all legal notices that are published in a newspaper must be published in that official newspaper. If the district does not designate an official newspaper, the district can choose to publish legal notices in any qualified newspaper. If no qualified newspaper is published within the school district, the school board can choose to publish legal notices in a newspaper likely to give notice.

In lieu of newspaper publication, the school board may direct that certain legal notices be posted. If the school board chooses to post these legal notices, the notice must be posted in at least 3 public places likely to give notice to persons affected <u>or</u> must be posted in at least one place likely to give notice and placed electronically on the school district's website. For notices required to be posted prior to acts or events, this notice must be posted no later than the time specified for the first newspaper publication, which will vary based on the class of the legal notice. For notices required to be posted after an act or event, this notice must be posted within one week after the act or event.

Only certain legal notices subject to Wis. Stat. Ch. 985 are eligible for posting in lieu of publication. Notices that are likely <u>ineligible</u> for posting in lieu of publication include:

- i. Notices of school board elections,
- ii. Notices related to school board referenda,
- iii. The proceedings of a school board, and
- iv. Notices related to specific individuals.

The option to post in lieu of publication does not change the notice requirements under the Open Meetings Law, which requires reasonable notice to the public of meetings. It is possible, in certain circumstances, that posting in one physical location and on the district website might be sufficient under the Open Meetings Law. However, the Wisconsin Attorney General continues to recommend that school boards post notice of their meetings in three locations. Posting meeting notices on a district's website could supplement those physical postings.

CHANGES TO THE REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS OF NEWSPAPERS THAT PUBLISH LEGAL NOTICES

In order for a school board to satisfy the legal requirements for publishing required legal notices in a newspaper, that newspaper must be qualified. 2017 Wisconsin Act 282 makes it easier for newspapers to be qualified in light of increased consolidations and mergers in the newspaper industry. Simultaneously, the new law more clearly excludes non-newspapers from being qualified. The new law defines a newspaper as a publication that is published at regular intervals and at least once a week, containing on average, 25 percent news content per issue. News content is defined as written information and images, other than advertisements, that are printed in a publication.

To be a newspaper qualified to publish legal notices, the newspaper must file a certificate with the county clerk stating that it is qualified under Wis. Stat. Ch. 985 and stating its place of publication. Checking with the county clerk is a good first step for school districts when determining in which newspaper to publish. However, the liability for improper publishing lies with the person charged with the legal duty of causing legal notices to be published, which in certain instances is the school board clerk. If that person causes a legal notice to be published in a newspaper that is not qualified or fails to cause a legal notice to be published in a qualified newspaper, that person may be fined up to \$100 for each offense. Each day in which a legal notice should have been published, but was not, counts as a separate offense. Even if a school board publishes legal notices in a qualified newspaper, the school board cannot publish in a non-qualified newspaper without risking a fine. Due to this liability, school boards should perform due diligence to ensure that the newspaper in which the district is publishing legal notices is qualified and if a qualified newspaper is published in the district.

In addition to filing that certificate, to be qualified to publish legal notices, a newspaper must have a bona fide circulation, meaning the publisher of the newspaper sells 50 percent or more of the circulation of the newspaper, <u>and</u> the publisher has actual subscribers at each publication of not less than 1,000 copies in 1st and 2nd class cities or 300 copies in 3rd and 4th class cities, villages, or towns. Additionally, the newspaper must meet one of the following criteria:

- i. For at least 2 of the 5 years immediately before the date of the publication of the legal notice, the newspaper has been published regularly and continuously in the city, village, or town where published;
- ii. The newspaper is a successor to a newspaper described in (i) above and the successor newspaper has resumed publication following succession within 30 days; or
- iii. The newspaper has merged or consolidated with one or more newspapers and one of the newspapers subject to the consolidation or merger has been continuously published at regular intervals of at least once each week for a least 50 issues each year for at least one year prior to the first publication of the notice.

If no newspaper in a city, village, or town satisfies these requirements (including the requirement of bona

fide circulation), a newspaper will be qualified if it is published regularly and continuously in the city, village, or town and publishing in the newspaper is likely to give notice in the area or to the affected person <u>and</u> the newspaper is otherwise qualified.

By law, a newspaper is "published" at the post office from which its mailing permit is issued. If the newspaper has no primary post office, then the newspaper must designate its place of publication. No newspaper can have more than one place of publication during the same period of time.

If no qualified newspaper is published within the school district, the publication of legal notices must be made in a newspaper likely to give notice. However, a "shopper" or other advertising publication that is less than 25% news content is not a newspaper, and publication of legal notices should not be made in such an advertising publication.

NEW OPTION FOR PUBLISHING CLASS 2 AND 3 LEGAL NOTICES

Current law provides for the publication of three types of legal notices, Class 1, Class 2, and Class 3. A Class 1 notice requires one insertion in a newspaper which must be at least one week before the act or event. A Class 2 notice requires two insertions in a newspaper, once a week for consecutive weeks, the last of which must be at least one week before the act or event. A Class 3 notice requires three insertions in a newspaper, once a week for consecutive weeks, the last of which must be at least one week before the act or event. A Class 3 notice requires three insertions in a newspaper, once a week for consecutive weeks, the last of which must be at least one week before the act or event. Class 3 notice requires three insertions in a newspaper, once a week for consecutive weeks, the last of which must be at least one week before the act or event. Certain statutes might provide for slightly different insertion requirements, but these are the default rules.

2017 Wisconsin Act 353 creates a new publication option for certain Class 2 and Class 3 notices. With certain exceptions, a school district may now publish a summary of the legal notice, in lieu of the entire legal notice, in the second and third insertions of a Class 2 or Class 3 notice. The summary must be accompanied by notice that the full text of the material included in the first insertion is available for viewing at all of the following locations:

- i. As an electronic document on the school board's website;
- ii. In the newspaper in which the initial insertion was published;
- iii. As an electronic document on the Wisconsin newspapers legal notices website; and,
- iv. In a readily accessible physical location within the school district.

School districts cannot publish summaries of legal notices required to be published by order of a court or for legal notices related to court proceedings required to be published. Depending on the length of the legal notice, a district might be able to save money on publication costs by taking advantage of this new option to publish just a summary and the additional required information in subsequent insertions of Class 2 and Class 3 notices.

CONCLUSION

The legal requirements for publication and posting of legal notices remain complex. However, the law provides a certain amount of flexibility for some legal notices. On the other hand, the law still requires physical publication in many circumstances, even at a time when the public increasingly accesses legal notices online.

Districts should evaluate their current practices regarding publication and posting of legal notices in light of

these changes to the law. A good first step for districts is to confer with the newspaper in which legal notices are currently being published. However, districts should recognize that the liability for improper publishing of legal notices is on the person with the legal duty to cause the notices to be published, not on the newspaper publishing the notices. As a result, districts should review their policies and practices and consult with legal counsel, when necessary.

In lieu of publication in a newspaper under s. 985.02(1), the board may elect to post in the manner specified under s. 985.02(2), which requires either posting in at least three public places likely to give notice to persons affected or posting in at least one public place likely to give notice to persons affected and placed electronically on an Internet site maintained by the district. [s. 985.05(1)].

- 4. Once submitted by the Strategic Planning Team, the strategies and action plans will be evaluated and, if appropriate, revised, dropped or supplanted by the Board of Education.

NEW SCHOOL BOARD MEMBER ORIENTATION

The Board of Education and the administrative staff shall assist each new member in understanding the functions, duties, policies, procedures and practices of the Board. The following is only a guideline and other information may be added.

New Board members shall receive those materials as identified by the Board. If the member does not have internet access or would prefer a hard copy of policies, a policy book will be provided. In addition, the District Administrator and Board President within six (6) weeks of the new member being seated, shall:

- 1. Meet with the new Board member to discuss the district administrator's relationship to the Board, the educational philosophy of the district, and details of the operation of the school district.
- 2. Arrange an opportunity for the new Board member to visit each school and meet the administrative staff.
- 3. Review with the new Board member the Board meeting agenda, including background materials and the procedure used at Board meetings.
- 4. Explain what materials are available to Board members and the procedures to be used in obtaining information from the district administrator.
- 5. Suggested topics may include, but are not limited to:
 - How to place an item on the agenda
 - How to call a special meeting
 - The use of legal services
 - The use of secretarial staff
 - The procedure for visiting schools by the public
 - Review student achievement data and trends
 - Review of the Policy Book
 - Review policies and procedures for Board expense reimbursement
- 6. Explain the function and services of the Wisconsin Association of School Boards and the Cooperative Education Service Agency.
- 7. Familiarize the new Board member with his/her general duties and responsibilities as well as Board member ethical standards.
- 8. Discuss preparation of the annual budget, monthly financial reports and district purchasing procedures.
- 9. Brief the new Board member on the status of current negotiations, district staffing needs and the procedure for handling public complaints about district personnel.
- 10. Discuss the district's curriculum development and review of academic support.
- 11. Discuss the district's non-academic services.

Beyond this, the new Board member is encouraged to take the initiative in seeking out further information that may be needed.

STUDENT FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES

The School District of Colby recognizes the need for student solicitation and fundraising activities to support student clubs, organizations and class functions. The School District of Colby strongly encourages student fundraising via community service projects. Likewise, the Board of Education strongly discourages the use of instructional time for any fund raising effort.

The following criteria are established in regard to student fundraising.

- 1) Clubs and organizations that require fundraising activities for membership must give students the option of contributing a higher dues fee in lieu of fundraising.
- 2) No child below the seventh grade or under the age of 12 may conduct "door to door" solicitation.
- 3) Each club, organization or class is limited to one "door to door" fundraiser each calendar year.
- 4) When conducting "door to door" solicitations, students must clearly identify themselves, the club organization, the class they represent and for what purpose(s) they are conducting the fundraiser.
- 5) All fundraisers must be approved in advance in writing by the activities director or building principal. Building principals shall establish accounting procedures to appropriately deposit funds.
- 6) Building principals or activities director will report to the board on, "door to door" fundraisers that have been scheduled as requested.
- 7) The District high school principal or activities director shall keep a calendar of district "door to door" fundraisers and communicate the scheduling of "door to door" fundraisers with other community youth groups.
- 8) This policy shall be communicated to all staff, coaches and advisors annually.

Definition of "door to door" fundraisers:

A fundraiser conducted by students that solicit funds from people via canvassing homes in neighborhoods and/or the community. Said canvassing is conducted from house to house.

"Door to door" fundraising does not mean:

- 1) In school sales
- 2) Solicitation of funds from family members
- 3) Solicitation of funds from large congregations of people

ENTRANCE AGE REVIEW

All children who are residents of the School District of Colby and who will be (5) (4) years of age on or before September 1 are eligible to attend pre-kindergarten. Children who are five (5) years of age on or before September 1 are eligible to attend kindergarten. Children who are six (6) years of age on or before September 1 are eligible to attend first grade.

Children who meet the age requirements of this state will be enrolled in school kindergarten and/or first grade at the beginning of the school year. Kindergarten screening and registrations will be held at the kindergarten centers during the month of March or April. Parents or guardians are asked to bring their child's immunization record and birth certificates to the registration. Children must present evidence of immunizations as required by law.

During the kindergarten screening, the child's vision, hearing and weight are checked and they are given a series of simple tests to determine their readiness for school. In addition, parents of three-year-old or four-year-old children who suspect that their child is having significant difficulty with learning, speech, hearing, vision, etc. are encouraged to schedule their child for screening. Students may be admitted early to Pre-K, kindergarten or first grade in accordance with established procedures.

No student shall be permitted to use an electronic paging device, laser pointer, or digital- or computer-generated communication device (including but not limited to cellular phone, beeper, personal camera or camera/phone, IPOD, MP3, or other entertainment device) without express authorization from an administrator or teacher on the school premises during school hours. The use of any digital device (photo, video, voice recording) in any locker room area is specifically prohibited and will result in consequence.

An exemption to this policy may be allowed for the use or possession of a cellular phone and/or pager electronic device if the Board of Education's designee (Building Principal or District Administrator) determines that the device is to be used for or is possessed for a medical, school, educational, vocational, or other legitimate use and permission is granted by the designee. In addition, the use of cellular phones during non instructional times may be authorized by the building principal.

This policy shall be published annually in school district student handbooks.

Whenever this policy is revised by the board, the District Administrator shall submit a copy of such policy to the State Superintendent of Public Instruction.

STUDENT FEES POLICY

The School District of Colby supports the need to provide a free public education to all children enrolled. The District may charge student fees for certain activities, courses and services which may require additional funding and may assess charges when school property is damaged or lost. No district wide student enrollment fees will be assessed.

Student fees will be reviewed by the Board Superintendent annually. Any new or increased student fees will be Board approved. Fee schedules shall be consistent with state and federal laws and regulations. Receipts for all student fees shall be completed.

Collection of Fees and Charges

The District Administrator or designee shall be expected to protect the taxpayers of the District by making every effort to collect all fees and charges due the District. The District may use small claims court or collection agencies/services to collect student's debts, fees and charges due to the district prior to issuance of the diplomas participation in Commencement.

General policy

The Board of Education shall furnish such textbooks, supplies, supplementary texts, and instructional materials as are necessary to the best implementation of the curriculum in all grades.

Exceptions (Any exception must be authorized by the principal.)

Expendable materials in the nature of laboratory manuals, bookkeeping workbooks, agriculture workbooks, and other aids that become the personal property of the student shall be purchased by the school and sold to the student at cost.

Any student who, through the course of instruction, produces any article for his their personal use or ownership, will pay the cost of the material used in the construction of each article.

The Board may also charge for instruction, instruments, or specialized equipment/apparatus necessary for study or extra-curricular involvements.

Part II SECTION 8. POST-EMPLOYMENT BENEFITS 8.01 Voluntary Early Retirement Benefit Program

A. Eligibility

Teachers will be eligible for the early retirement benefit provided for in this Article if a) they declare, in writing, to the Board of Education, their retirement intentions prior to February 1 of the calendar year in which they intend to retire from an employer contributing to the Wisconsin Retirement System, b) are WRS eligible for retirement and c) were hired prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

B. Application and Limitation

Application for participation in the early retirement benefit provided for in this Article must be made by the teacher in writing and submitted to the School Board on or before February 1st of the last school year prior to retirement from an employer contributing to the Wisconsin Retirement System. No more than three (3) teachers shall be eligible to begin participation in the early retirement benefits provided for in this Article in the same year unless the School Board, at its sole discretion, approves a higher number. In the event there are more applicants than are eligible to participate, the most senior applicants, based on Colby School District experience, will be selected. If seniority is equal, the selection will be based on the order of receipt of the application.

C. Early Retirement Benefit Health Insurance

For Staff hired prior to July 1, 1986

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for insurance premiums upon retirement.

2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.

3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 1986, yet prior to July 1, 1992

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$100,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.

2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.

3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 1992, yet prior to July 1, 2004.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$75,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.

2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.

3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2004, yet prior to July 1, 2009.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$50,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.

2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.

3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2009, yet prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon retirement, for an eligible teacher whose application has been approved, the District will credit up to three thousand dollars for each year of service (\$3,000 x years of service at the Colby School District, up to a maximum of \$25,000) for the retiree for a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) until the teacher becomes entitled to Medicare.

1) Each qualifying teacher shall have \$3,000, or such amount as proportional to the employment status of the teacher pursuant to his/her letter of appointment, designated in an HRA (Health Retirement Account) to be used for health insurance premiums upon retirement. The HRA may be funded or unfunded as determined by the District unless otherwise required by law.

2) In the event of death of the retiree, his or her spouse will be eligible to the above credits on the above basis as if the retiree was still living through the eligibility period reflected in this benefit offering had the employee survived.

3) There is no cash equivalency benefit available under this provision for the retiree or any surviving spouse.

For Staff hired after July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon employment, for an eligible teacher, the District will contribute \$500 annually (each year of service) to a premium only health reimbursement account (HRA) for utilization upon retirement from the Colby School District.

D. Payment of Benefit

1a) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 1986

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, a monthly benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by the number of months until the employee becomes entitled to Medicare eligibility. 1b) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 2013 2009.

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, an annual benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by 5.

2) Retired employees may use the HRA credit for premium only health reimbursement account from a third party vendor selected by the district.

3) Retired employees who return to work in any position which offers health insurance shall have their benefit suspended until they no longer work in a position that is eligible for health insurance, subject to the terms for participation eligibility. Upon termination of any health insurance qualifying post retirement employment, monthly benefits with the Colby School District will be recalculated as described in Part II, Section 8, D(1a) and D(1b).

4) Decisions made by the District in the interpretation and operation of this benefit offering shall be in its sole discretion and are final and binding. In the event of any review of a decision by a court of law, the reviewing tribunal shall give deference to the District's decision, confirming such decision, unless it is shown that the District acted in an arbitrary and capricious manner. The decision of the District on all issues under this offering shall be final.

D. Payment of Benefit

1a) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 1986

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, a monthly benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by the number of months until the employee becomes entitled to Medicare eligibility.

1b) For Staff hired prior to July 1, 20132009

Upon Board approval of the retirement date, an annual benefit is determined by dividing the total benefit credit by 5.

2) Retired employees may use the HRA credit for premium only health reimbursement account from a third party vendor selected by the district.

3) Retired employees who return to work in any position which offers health insurance shall have their benefit suspended until they no longer work in a position that is eligible for health insurance, subject to the terms for participation eligibility. Upon termination of any health insurance qualifying post retirement employment, monthly benefits with the Colby School District will be recalculated as described in Part II, Section 9, D(1a) and D(1b).

4) Decisions made by the District in the interpretation and operation of this benefit offering shall be in its sole discretion and are final and binding. In the event of any review of a decision by a court of law, the reviewing tribunal shall give deference to the District's decision, confirming such decision, unless it is shown that the District acted in an arbitrary and capricious manner. The decision of the District on all issues under this offering shall be final.
