PRIVACY IN LOCKER ROOMS

Locker rooms are provided for the use of physical education students, athletes and other activity groups or individuals authorized by the building principal. The District recognizes the privacy rights of individuals using the locker room and shall take reasonable measures to protect an individual's privacy.

The District shall take the following reasonable measures to protect the privacy of individuals using the school locker rooms:

- Under no circumstances can a person use a camera, video recorder, cell phone or other recording device to capture, record or transfer a representation of a nude or partially nude person in the locker room. Any other use of a camera, video recorder or other recording device in the locker room requires the prior permission of the building principal or designated locker room supervisor and the person being photographed, videotaped or recorded.
- Only coaches/advisors and other authorized Colby School District personnel may enter and remain in a locker room to interview or seek information from any individuals in the locker room.
- No media is allowed access to locker rooms before, during or after any school athletic event
 or practice. Coaches and student athletes may be available for interviews directly outside the
 locker rooms, consistent with District policy and school rules.

Anyone who violates this policy shall be subject to school disciplinary action and/or penalties under state law.

The building principal or designated locker room supervisor, as applicable, shall be responsible for enforcing this policy.

This policy shall be posted in every school locker room in the District.
