- 5. That the proration of costs to each participating district be estimated prior to June 30, annually, on the basis of pupil participation for each school district, and state special education reimbursements will be prorated in the same manner and reimbursed to the participating districts; the proration of said tuition payments assumes that these payments are made with local state aidable funds;
- That transportation, if required, is to be furnished by the district of residence and the special transportation aid shall also be claimed by the district of residence;
- 7. That the estimated budget and plan of operation (see reverse), including payment schedule for this cooperative, shall be approved in advance of contract signing by all school district parties hereto;

# RELATIONS WITH FAMILY AND COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS (SUNDAY ACTIVITIES)

The Colby School District will not schedule student activities, including athletic practices, club meetings, play practices, band practices, or choir practices on Sunday, except as follows:

- Athletic practices may be scheduled on a Sunday on the RARE occasion that a WIAA tournament game is scheduled on a Monday or Tuesday or in the case of a regular season game being scheduled on the next Monday. These practices must have prior approval from the athletic director and/or principal. In addition, the coach will notify the parents of the involved athletes.
- Play practices, band practices, and choir practices may be scheduled on Sunday if they have a Monday performance. These practices must have prior approval from the principal. In this instance, the advisor will notify the parents of the involved students.
- Any other exceptions must be approved in advance by the building principal. Final determination will be made by the district administrator. Scheduling of consistent practices (more than twice in a month) must be approved by the Board of Education. Exceptions should be kept to a minimum.

Any student requesting in advance to the director/coach, will be released from Sunday activities for family and community organizational activities.
