Graduation Requirements – 24 Credits

Required: 16 Credits Electives: 8 Credits

Also, .5 credit must be completed during the senior year unless a student has applied for early graduation. An English class will suffice as the senior elective only if the student is graduating early.

Juniors may choose to take one or more of these classes, knowing the classes count only for an elective credit. Students must pass .5 credit of English during the senior year in one of these classes: Composition I, Great Novels, Contemporary Literature, British and World Literature, Classical Mythology and Short Stories, TC/CC English 110 – Introduction to College English
