## Money Game

This game is for two to four players.
Materials needed:
Approximately 30 pennies, 10 nickels, 10 dimes, 15 quarters, and 1
 dice.

To play: First player rolls the dice. They take the amount of money that is rolled on the dice. Ex. $1=1$ penny, $2=2$ pennies, $5=1$ nickel.

The other players each take their turn in the same way. On player one's second turn they again take the dice and roll it. They take the amount of money indicated.

Before handing the dice on to the next player they must check to see if they can trade in their coins for a higher coin. Ex. 5 pennies for a nickel, two dimes and a nickel for a quarter. They must make all trades possible. When they have made all the trades they can hand the dice to the next player.

At this time the others players can check to see that all trades were made. If the player missed making a trade they have to return all of their money and start over. Play continues in this way until a person can trade in 4 quarters for a dollar. That person is the winner.
