Virtual Learning Day Materials

Reading: Read rhyming stories and nursery rhymes with your child. Make up silly sentences (Fred frog fidgets with fireflies) and have them count how many words they hear in the sentence. Sound out and write CVC words, ex. cat, map, dog. Read stories to your child. Having them listen to good reading will help them become good readers!

Writing: Practice writing your name the "Kindergarten Way". The first letter is uppercase the rest are lowercase. Remember to start at the top when we write!

Math: Practice counting by 1's and 10's to 100. Count everything around you (how many snacks, how many toys, chairs, etc). Play board or card games. Have a shape or color search around your house.

Science: We have talked a lot about colors and what new colors we can make when we mix two colors together. Feel free to continue exploring with paint, shaving cream, food coloring, etc. Have some fun outside in the snow, build a snowman!

Social Studies: We have been working on school rules, being helpful friends and classmates and learning what that looks like. Feel free to continue talking about how that would look at home.
